When you are looking to buy a high-end camper trailer, you really want to know what you're getting. Is it going to last, be easy to set up and have all of the conveniences? If you are spending up to and above \$50,000, you don't want any surprises.

Aussie Swag Campers have every single bell and whistle you could fit. After looking at the specification list, you can see why it carries a \$47,800 price tag. When it opens up in a matter of minutes and you can be cooking dinner not long after, you quickly come to appreciate the quality design and workmanship of this trailer.

For this test we had a family of five along with us for two weeks to get a real-world look at exactly how this trailer performs.

Glen, his wife Amanda and their three young kids Bethany (10), Nathan (5) and Emilia 'Millie' (2) met us early one morning in Sydney's west for a two-week outback trip. After almost 10 hours driving on the first day and with three kids in tow, Glen and Amanda had managed to get everything set up before we even had a chance to help them.

The kettle was already boiling, making use of the pullout and swing around kitchen which ends up sitting flush with the camper body. The four burners were a little cramped when dealing with large pots and pans, but the heat out of them was great, as was the grill.

The sink is plumbed into the camper's electric hot water system, which made washing up convenient. In fact, of the six

camper trailers we had with us on this trip, we used this kitchen and one other almost exclusively. So well featured, and so close to the 80L Waeco fridge, everything was dead easy. The swing around design meant we didn't have to walk around the kitchen every time we needed something from the pantry. The only qualm we had with the kitchen was the position of the 12V light; although a good feature, it would be more useful if mounted higher.

For two weeks the camper slept Mum and Dad on the high-density foam bed, while the three kids slept on the floor. An optional kid's room is available, although the Wright family (different Wright family to the Glenn Wright who steers this ship) didn't seem to have any issues with the space.

Underneath the bed, Aussie Swag have fitted a generous drawer perfect for clothes and the like. Under there you will also find the 12V system, which includes both 12 and 240V outlets, a 240V, 40A charger, and 700W pure sine inverter. The system is run primarily off the two 105Ah AGM batteries, can be charged by the vehicle, 130W solar panel or directly via the Honda 10i generator. Other interior features are the LED strip light across the roof and the egg shell top on the mattress for a comfy night's sleep.

An electric hot water system is a standard feature on the Ultra and comes complete with its own shower room. The convenience of a good wash after a couple of days of dusty driving is worth its weight in gold, and no-one who used it complained of a lack of hot water. The system
